The typical cause of a release is that the various components of a fuel system are either not in compliance with applicable codes and standards or they have deteriorated to the point of being non-functional. Overfill valves, anti-siphon valves and oil safety valves are essential for many fuel systems and un-needed for others.



For example, oil safety valves must be installed at the bottom drain of a tank to properly function. Conversely, anti-siphon valves must be located on the top of a tank. These are some of the critical items that are not appreciated by many installers. This lack of understanding is what allows so many very preventable fuel releases to occur.
